Hungary belongs to the classical Danube countries and was a founding member of the FID (now CEDA). Professor Imre Magyar, the founder and first president of the Hungarian Diabetes Association, contributed to the founding of FID as well. In 1971 and in 1981, Professor Imre Magyar also served as the organizer of the annual scientific FID meetings in Hungary.

It was a privilege for me, when Professor Helmut Schatz invited me to organize a third FID meeting in Hungary. Fortunately, the meeting organized in June 2012 was highly successful, with more than 450 participants. The number of international participants exceeded the number of those coming from Hungary. Indeed, we have a lot of uncertainties concerning the fourth CEDA/FID congress, to be organized in Budapest between 10–12 June 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Originally, I have planned to involve participants from countries which were less involved in CEDA activities up till now. Taking the current pandemic situation into consideration, we need to be prepared for a face-to-face, an online and a hybrid meeting as well. The recently renovated 4 star Ra-

disson Blu Béke Hotel has been chosen as the congress hotel located in the heart of Budapest, with excellent traffic connections. All aspects of clinical diabetology are planned to be covered by the scientific program. As neuropathy has been my area of research for almost 40 years, I intend to put more emphasis on pathogenesis, diagnosis and treatment of different aspects of diabetic neuropathy.

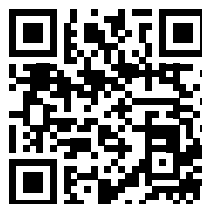
We would like to kindly invite all current and future members of CEDA/FID to the 52nd Annual Scientific Congress in 2021 in Budapest.
